

Changes in the Restrictive Covenants
Approved by the Members, April 5, 2003

ARTICLE II USE OF SUBDIVISION LOTS

- C. THE PURCHASERS OF LOT NUMBERS 95, 126, 127, 138, 139, 140, 141 and 142 in section "M" may use said lots as campsites. No more than two (2) campsites shall be located on any numbered lot. When the use of any of the above listed numbered lots as a campsite is discontinued, then said lot or lots shall be used only for residential purposes and be subject to all provisions and conditions of this instrument.

ARTICLE VI PROPERTY MAINTENANCE

- A. OWNERS OF LOTS WITHIN THE SUBDIVISION shall at all times maintain their property in an orderly manner, not permitting the:
1. accumulation of undergrowth, vines, and weeds on improved property.

To be added to the Definitions section of the **Covenants**

Improved property - one upon which changes have been made, either by construction or by the clearing of vegetation. Any structures or constructions which are visible, without trespass, to a passerby on the street must be kept in good repair and in a sightly condition. Once cleared, the portions cleared, if visible, without trespass, to a passerby on the street must be either kept cleared and tidy or replanted.
